Show full understanding of decontamination equipment functionality and associated validation (daily weekly monthly and annual) testing requirements; consequently carryout routine tests in accordance with Quality standards and guidance. Take direction from seniors and coordinate tasks appropriately, to ensure endoscopes and theatre instruments are readily available in accordance with patient scheduling and ensure that emergency requirements take priority; also confirm processes are followed to ensure endoscopes and instruments are available for out of hours use. To effectively operate reprocessing equipment in accordance with manufacturer guidance, this will require manual dexterity and concentration. To use manual dexterity and concentration for the disassembly and reassembly of the reusable medical devices in accordance with Manufacturer's instructions. Maintain accurate high quality traceability records of all endoscopes, endoscopic accessories, theatre instruments, library devices and ancillaries using the technology provided or manual records when appropriate, to ensure central record keeping is accurate to real time To monitor and take responsibility for the ordering of accessories and equipment to maintain unit stock levels as agreed with the decontamination manager and within Trust Standing Financial Instructions. Responsible for keeping all work areas clean and tidy and maintain a safe, pleasant environment following departmental procedures. Ensure that maintenance problems are reported to Estates promptly and liaise with clinical teams accordingly to inform of possible delays. Always communicate with service users and other healthcare staff in a polite, professional and helpful manner, seeking senior advice where required. Participate in the delivery and return of equipment to/from clinical areas as required using the procedure for safe transport of equipment. - Ensure routine tests are undertaken and recorded in accordance with the Planned Preventative Maintenance Schedules, Quality Standards and Guidance.
- Undertake regular audits of decontamination and sterilisation processes and action any discrepancies to departmental guidelines.
- To adhere to the recommendations for the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) and risk assessments appropriate to the clinical area.
- Inspect equipment within the decontamination cycle to ensure processes are effective
- Recognise devices by name and ensure theatre trays endoscopes are repacked correctly with correct instruments ancillary items, responsible for checking loan devices/trays and ensuring the correct items delivered prior to clinical use.
- Attend and participate in departmental meetings
- Support the development or refreshing standard operating procedures according to service change and modernisation
- Will come into contact with remnants of blood, body tissue or offensive by-products as part of the cleaning cycles
