CTM is divided into three integrated group localities (ILGs):

- **Bridgend Locality** This area covers Bridgend and some of the Vale of the Glamorgan. The acute hospital site is the Princess of Wales. It is a regional trauma centre, a child and adolescent mental health unit, large eye unit and a multi-professional education centre. The community hospital is Tonteg Hospital. The ILG Director is Anthony Gibson.
- Merthyr Cynon Locality This area covers the large town of Merthyr Tydfil and its surroundings. The acute hospital site is Prince Charles Hospital. It is a regional trauma centre, acute stroke centre with maternity and neonatal services. It provides regional oral and maxillofacial services. The community hospital Ysbyty Cwm Cynon is based in Aberdare. It is also home to Keir Hardie Park bringing community and education services together. The ILG Director is Sarah Spencer.
- Rhondda Taf Ely Locality This area covers Llantrisant, Pontypridd and the Rhondda Valleys. The acute hospital site is the Royal Glamorgan Hospital. It has a state of the art diagnostic hub, is the centre of excellence for acute medicine and has a new palliative care Unit Y Bwthyn. The community hospital Ysbyty Cwm Rhondda is based in Llwynypia. The ILG Director is Stuart Hackwell.

Childcare Facilities


Each acute hospital has a nursery on site. These include;




Our Values and Behaviours
